

Introduction

The Cancer Center of Acadiana is dedicated to ensuring you have the resources you need to receive medical care wherever you are. During a natural disaster, the thought of having to evacuate your home is already a terrifying thought for so many but, there's added concern for those receiving care for their diagnosis and how they'll continue their care plan while weathering the storm. This booklet, designed to be kept with you in the event of an evacuation, contains essential information to make sure your care is never interrupted in an emergency—and will help make sure the process is as smooth as possible.

Section I – this section compiles essential information you may need to have with you while you are away from home. Some information may seem commonplace and obvious, but it never hurts to have all these details in one place. If you were to need treatment elsewhere, these details may expedite the intake process at the new facility.

Section II – this section includes steps to take before you leave to ensure you are prepared.

Section III – One benefit of being a part of the Ochsner system is the number of facilities in the Louisiana and Mississippi area.

Section IV – We have included treatment info cards to serve as representation of the treatment you are receiving in case you cannot speak for yourself.

Keep this booklet nearby during your evacuation or time at home during the storm. Make sure you have read through it and have filled out all the appropriate sections. Feel free to reach out with any questions or concerns.

Section II: What to Do Before You Evacuate

Be sure to have refills of all of your important medications (at least 2 weeks’ worth, if possible). If you cannot obtain the refills before you go, make sure you find pharmacies near your evacuation destination and update your provider as soon as possible.

Make sure you have an active MyHealth account. If you need assistance setting up your account call 877-621-8014 for assistance

In your MyHealth portal:

- Send a message to your provider(s) informing them of your evacuation location
- Print out or save a copy of your most recent After Visit Summary (found under health record, “visit summaries”)

Fill out all information in section I of this booklet, including all current medications and prior/ current conditions that may affect your care.

Section IV includes a printable wallet card for chemotherapy or immunotherapy treatments. If you are currently on either of these treatments, complete the wallet card, cut it out and place it in your wallet or purse for emergencies.

Be sure to bring this booklet with you when you evacuate!
